Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the city of Allentown is desirous of submitting a formal application to the U.S. Department of Transportation for grant funding for a minimum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the city of Allentown, Lehigh County hereby requests a Safe Streets and Roads for All grant to advance and complete an Action Plan which goals are to develop holistic, well-defined strategies to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries in the city of Allentown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, if awarded the city of Allentown, aims to complete the Safe Streets and Roads for All Action Plan, in less than twenty-four months. With an eventual goal of applying to the Safe Streets and Roads Implementation grant to achieve zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the city of Allentown hereby designates Matt Tuerk Mayor, and Seth O'Neill, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the U.S. Department of Transportation.
