AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2022 Capital Fund Budget to provide for an increase of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$650,000) Dollars to the new Capital Project "Mack Blvd Lighting Upgrade". These funds have been awarded as a MTF-DCED reimbursable grant to replace the old street lights on Mack Blvd. from Emmaus Ave. to Rail Road underpass with a new LED lights, new poles, foundation and wiring.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the Capital Fund with the following account:

Mack Blvd Lighting Upgrade

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after final passage.

The Bureau of Traffic has applied and been awarded a MTF-DCED reimbursable grant for \$650,000 to replace the old street lights on Mack Blvd. from Emmaus Ave. to Rail Road underpass with a new LED lights, new poles, foundation and wiring.
