AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2022 ARPA Fund Budget to provide for a transfer of Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand (\$2,700,000) Dollars for the Little Lehigh Project.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That the City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the ARPA Fund in the amount of Two Million Seven Hundred Thousand (\$2,700,000) Dollars as follows:

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

Summary and Facts of the Bill

Transfers funds from the unappropriated balance of the ARPA Fund to support the Little Lehigh Project being developed by the Allentown Housing Authority.

The Allentown Housing Authority is redeveloping the public housing project originally constructed in the early 1970's. Since then the building exterior and interiors have experience significant wear and tear and are in need of rehab. Not only will the development replace the existing deteriorating units, but it will also revitalize the neighborhood and provide much needed high quality affordable housing for the community.

The development of affordable housing to increase supply of affordable and high quality living units is an eligible use of ARPA funds per 42 U.S.C. 803.603(c)(1)(A), and the interim final rule 31 C.F.R. 35.6(b)(12)(ii)(B). The Final Rule states that "Treasury will presume that any projects that would be eligible for funding under either the [HTF] or...the Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME) are eligible uses of SLFRF funds.
