AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2022 Trexler Fund, by transferring supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Fund in the amount of a total of Sixty-Five Thousand (\$65,000) Dollars from the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Capital Budget to the Cedar Creek Bridges capital project, to repair the vehicular bridge at Ott St in Cedar Creek Parkway.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a transfer from the Trexler Fund to the Capital Fund in the following manner:

Department of Parks and Recreation

- **Summary and Facts of the Bill**

Move funds from the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Capital Budget and place those funds in the Cedar Creek Bridges capital project. A total of \$65,000.00 needs to be appropriated into the Capital account to repair the vehicular bridge at Ott St in Cedar Creek Parkway. This is part of the 2022-23 Trexler Capital Project allocation.
