Introduced by City Council on March 21, 2018

Expresses gratitude to FBI and Federal Prosecutors

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, Federal agents raided Allentown City Hall and Mayor Edwin Pawlowski's home on July 2, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Edwin Pawlowski was found guilty on March 1, 2018 on 47 of 54 charges, including conspiracy, bribery, attempted extortion, mail and wire fraud, and lying to the FBI in a scheme to solicit campaign donations from law firms and vendors in exchange for city contracts; and

WHEREAS, the conviction was a result of the excellent work and dedication of FBI Special Agent Scott Curtis, the lead investigator since April of 2013; and Prosecutors Tony Wzorek and Michelle Morgan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Allentown City Council on behalf of the residents of Allentown hereby thanks the FBI and prosecutors for helping to rid the city of corruption and restore integrity and honesty in government and in the delivery of government services.
