Authorization for a change in an existing contract over \$10,000 – a change of \$24,509 with Telco, Inc. for – for repairs as a result of an accident – the original quote was for \$25,435.20 but additional monies were needed for repairs.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Allentown to increase the contractual sum of the previously awarded agreement with the following named contractor/consultant, for the use and purpose indicated in supporting the Recommendation of Award or Purchase Order dated October 9, 2020:

Description of project or scope of services to be provided and why is an increase needed:

On or about April 8, 2020, a non-city employee vehicle accident occurred on or about East Hamilton Street and Albert Street. Three (3) quotes were obtained in order to repair the damage that occurred, and the lowest quote was awarded to the Vendor for the amount of \$25,435.20. At that time, since this was an informal quote and was well below the pricing thresholds, it did not require Council approval. During the course of the project it was discovered that the proposed 25' mast arm needed to be relocated in order to avoid the ATT duct bank underneath the proposed foundation location. Due to the relocation, the size of the mast arm needed to be increased from original proposed size of 25' to 30'.

meaning the City would have to purchase a new 30' mast arm. This increase will cost an additional \$24,509.00. Since this project is going over thresholds, it was put before the Change Order Committee for review and approval and at this time it now needs to be reviewed and approved by Council.
