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AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2016 General Fund Budget by transferring \$165,000 from the unappropriated balance to the Building Standards and Safety Bureau Other Contract Services account for the demolition of properties in the 300 Block of North Tenth Street as a result of the sink hole that was discovered in 2012.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the 2016 General Fund in the amount of One Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand (\$165,000.00) Dollars as follows:

**Bureau of Building Standards and Safety  
Building, Plumbing, Electrical Enforcement**

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SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

- **What Department or bureau is Bill originating from? Where did the initiative for the bill originate?**

Bureau of Building Standards and Safety

- **Summary and Facts of the Bill**

Unappropriated 2015 balance for this project in the amount of \$165,000 was not rolled over into 2016. The bureau delayed the work, anticipating additional funding to be provided by HUD, but the HUD funding may not be able to be applied to this project.

A sink hole opened underneath the properties and the properties were at risk of collapsing. The properties were demolished after it was determined that they could not be saved. The site was deemed a public safety risk.

The project would have been completed last winter without the delay of anticipating federal funds.
