Acknowledging that the City of Allentown would like to file an application for the 2023 Childhood Obesity Prevention and Environmental Health and Sustainability Grant in the amount of \$175,000.00; the maximum amount given to a medium size city.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from The United States Conference of Mayors and the American Beverage Foundation for a Healthy America (ABFHA), for a hybrid program in Allentown targeted towards childhood obesity prevention, and environmental health and sustainability; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that currently, about 20% of children in America have prevalence of childhood obesity, Pennsylvania in particular ranks number 9 for childhood obesity in the country the Council of the City of Allentown hereby approves of the submission to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development of the Action Plan for the period January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Allentown will conduct the required citizen participation process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Allentown administration will assure the provision of other necessary funds to make the activity feasible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2023 Childhood Obesity Prevention and Environmental Health and Sustainability Grant will tentatively fund \$175,000.00, to initiate and develop a program to address issues in childhood obesity, environmental health, and sustainability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriate officer of the City of Allentown is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this Resolution and to furnish a copy of this Resolution to The United States Conference of Mayors and ABFHA during grant submission.
