Introduced by the Administration on March 16, 2022

Designates the Mayor and Finance Director as approved official(s) to execute all documents pertaining to PennDOT Multimodal Grant Award of Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty (\$830,750) to Support the 15th Street Corridor Traffic Signal Upgrade Project.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown, Lehigh County has requested and been awarded a Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant in the amount of \$830,750 from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to fund improvements to the lighting on the 15th Street corridor and extend the system to Highland Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown hereby designates Matthew A. Tuerk, Mayor, and Seth O'Neill, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the Department of Transportation to facilitate the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Allentown, hereby authorizes acceptance of the award and the Mayor and Finance Director to execute all grant contract documents.

The City has been awarded a Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Multimodal Transportation Fund grant in the amount of \$830,7500. This grant will fund the 15th Street Corridor-Traffic Signals and Systems Extension. Council passed Resolution No. 124 on November 4, 2020 authorizing the submission of the application and naming the former Mayor and Purchasing Agent as approved signatories. The contract has just been issued, but PennDOT requires an updated Resolution that names the Mayor and Finance Director as approved official to execute all contracts.
