Introduced by the Administration on June 4, 2025

Authorization for Contract with Michael Baker International, Inc. in the amount of \$161,037.03 to conduct a study to provide a condition assessment and analysis of all signalized intersections as it relates to the existing traffic signal features and overhead sign structure poles currently maintained by the City. Three (3) proposals were received; however, two (2) proposals were rejected. Contract shall be for one (1) year with two (2) additional one (1) year renewal terms beyond the contract expiration period.

WHEREAS, Article 130.16 of the City's Administrative Code (recodified as §5-21) requires City Council approval by Resolution for the award of contracts or engagement of professional services.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Allentown to enter into an agreement with the aforementioned Contractor, for the use and purpose indicated in supporting the Recommendation of Award of Bid:

- Description of project or scope of services to be provided:

On April 7, 2025, the City advertised a solicitation for qualified firms to conduct a study to provide a condition assessment and analysis of all signalized intersections as it relates to the existing traffic

signal features and overhead sign structure poles currently maintained by the City. On May 5, 2025, a public opening was held, for which three (3) proposals were received. However, two (2) proposals were rejected due to including cost in their technical proposal. The proposal was distributed to all committee members via Teams for evaluation. The Technical evaluation was held on May 16, 2025, all committee members were present. The proposal was scored based on the following: IBE Preference (10 Points), Qualifications (15 Points), Research Plan (30 Points), and Timeline Requirements (25 Points). The Cost Proposal was opened on May 16, 2025, and distributed to all committee members via Teams for evaluation after the Technical evaluation. The Cost evaluation was held on May 21, 2025, all committee members were present. The committee discussed the Cost proposal (30 Points). The committee decided to not move forward with Oral presentation. The committee is recommending award to Michael Baker International, Inc.

The Contract term shall commence upon full execution and shall cease one (1) year thereafter.

Upon written agreement, this contract may be extended for up to an additional two (2) one (1) year renewal terms beyond the contract expiration period.
