No.__ RESOLUTION R141 - 2025

Introduced by the Administration on October 1, 2025

Authorizes the submission of the formal application to the Pennsylvania Office of the Budget for a grant of Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000.00) to support the Allentown Art Museum.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown, Lehigh County hereby requested a Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program grant for \$7,500,000 from the Pennsylvania Office of the Budget to support the Allentown Art Museum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown hereby designates Matthew Tuerk Mayor, and Bina Patel, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the Commonwealth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Allentown, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown to submit and accept Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000.00) in Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program funds to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Office of the Budget.

What department or bureau is this bill originating from?

This bill originates from the Department of Community and Economic Development Grants Department on behalf of the Allentown Art Museum.

• Summary and facts of the bill.

The Allentown Art Museum is submitting a formal application to the Pennsylvania Office of the Budget (OB), for \$7,500,000 awarded in Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) funds that will support the construction of a new and purpose-built museum.

The Resolution is a requirement of the application to demonstrate the City's support for the project and to designate Mayor Matthew Tuerk as the signatory of the contract with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

c. How does this bill relate to the City's vision/mission/priorities?

This bill allows for a state-of-the-art facility for the residents and visitors of the City of Allentown.
