AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2024 Federal Grants Fund to provide for a supplemental appropriation of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Bureau of Family Health Lead Abatement Grant.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the State Grant Revenue balance of the 2024 Federal Grants Fund in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Pennsylvania Department of Health as follows:
