AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2016 Grant Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of \$1,700.00 from the PA Historical and Museum Commission, to provide for training for the Historical Architectural Review Board (HARB).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2016 grant Fund in the amount of One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$1,700.00) reflecting receipt of monies from the PA Historical and Museum Commission, to provide for training for the Historical Architectural Review Board (HARB).

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the grant Fund in the amount of One Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars (\$1,700.00).

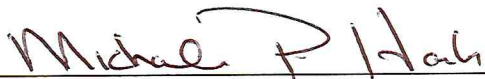

The program is a presentation by a speaker experienced in historic preservation and economic development. The amount of the grant is \$1700 for the consultants fees expenses.
