**RESOLUTION**

Authorizes the submission of a Formal Application for funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant (MTF-PennDOT) Grant Services in the amount of approximately One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for pedestrian safety improvements on three blocks of Hamilton Street (12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 14<sup>th</sup> Street).

**Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Multimodal Transportation Fund (MTF-PennDOT) Grant, for pedestrian safety improvements at three intersections on Hamilton Street (12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 14<sup>th</sup> Street). These safety upgrades will improve the safety and mobility of pedestrians at these three intersections.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Allentown City Council, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown to submit the application for approximately One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) in Multimodal Transportation Funds (MTF-PennDOT) to the Commonwealth Financing Authority.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Allentown hereby designates Matt Tuerk, Mayor, and Bina Patel, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requesting grant.
