AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2025 Grant Fund to provide for a supplemental appropriation of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from the PA DCED Local Share Account Grant. These funds are a pass-through grant that will support the Baum School of Art.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the Grant Fund in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from PA DCED as follows:

- **What department or bureau is this bill originating from?**

Department of Community and Economic Development. This Bill is the result of the successful application and award of the Local Share Account (LSA) grant for The Baum School of Art expansion project.

- **Summary and facts of the bill.**

The Baum School of Art, the Subgrantee, submitted a formal application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED), for which the City will serve as the Grantee. The \$1,000,000 awarded in LSA funds will be used for expansion and redevelopment of infrastructure costs to The Baum School of Art.

This Bill distributes funds as specified within the LSA grant application and award regulations.

- b. What are the benefits of doing this?**

The Baum School of Art serves as a long-time, valued community resource in downtown Allentown.

This Bill supports the renovation costs of the art school that serves Allentown residents and visitors alike, non-profit organizations and other community groups as an arts and culture resource.

This is a PA DCED funded project, and all costs are covered by this grant. The total grant award is One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to be allocated to the Grant Fund. All grant revenue will be appropriated to 005-00-0000-0000-46213 Grant Fund, LSA Grants. The expenses will be appropriated to the Grant Fund, 005-09-0901-0083-50048.

The project benefits the residents of Allentown as well as it brings additional revenue to the city through tourism.
