Introduced by the Administration on August 17, 2022

Authorizes the submission of the City's application for the Department of Justice's 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Grant in the amount of Fifty - One Thousand Two Hundred and Thirty-Six Dollars (\$51,236.00)

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, that

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from The United States Department of Justice for the Edward Byrne Memorial annual grant allocation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG grant will allow funds for violent crime suppression and drug investigations via patrol presence and data collection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Allentown will conduct the required citizen participation process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Allentown Police will assure the provision of other necessary funds to make the activity feasible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG grant will tentatively fund \$51,236.00 to pay overtime for patrol.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriate officer of the City of Allentown is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this Resolution and to furnish a copy of this Resolution to The United States Department of Justice.
