AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2025 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Forty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Six Dollars (\$46,766) from the Department of Justice for 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG grant to the City of Allentown Police Department to utilize the funding evidence workflow management system and portable weighing scales. A portion of this funding is appropriated as a pass through to Lehigh County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation of Forty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Six Dollars (\$46,766) to the following account:

Purpose of the ordinance is to amend the 2025 General Fund Budget to provide a supplemental appropriation of Forty-six thousand seven hundred, sixty-six dollars (\$ 46,766) from the Department of Justice for 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG grant to the City of Allentown Police Department to utilize the funding evidence workflow management system and portable weighing scales. A portion of this funding is appropriated as a pass through to Lehigh County.

This is an allocation of \$ 46,766 by Department of Justice for 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG. The funding will allow for the purchase of evidence workflow management system and portable weighing scales for the City of Allentown in the amount of \$ 21,290. The Lehigh County portion of this funding is \$ 25,476.

The goal of this funding to provide a workflow management system for the Police Department evidence custodian to streamline intake and holding procedure for physical evidence and portable weighing scales for the weighing of commercial vehicles.

The funding for the workflow management system will assist the police departments property officers to better manage the processing, organization and maintenance of criminal evidence. The portable weighing scales funding will also support the department's ability to enforce roadway regulations.
