AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2025 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Eighty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$85,900.00) from the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) Grant to the City of Allentown Police Department. These funds will be utilized for reimbursement of expenses for the purchase of portable breath testing devices, impaired driving simulator kit, trailer and training for officers.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation of Eighty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$85,900.00) to the following account:

Purpose of the ordinance is to amend the 2025 General Fund Budget to provide a supplemental appropriation of Eighty-five thousand, nine hundred \$ 85,900 from the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) Grant to the City of Allentown Police Department to utilize the funding for reimbursement of expenses for the purchase of portable breath testing devices, impaired driving simulator kit, trailer and training for officers.

This is an allocation of \$ 85,900 by Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) Local Law Enforcement Grant Program.
