ORDINANCES FOR FINAL PASSAGE (To be Voted On):

15-759 Bill 17 Parks and Recreation, this evening Amending the 2016 Trexler Fund, 2016 Golf Fund and the 2016 Capital Fund by transferring from the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Fund to various accounts within the Trexler Fund, Golf Fund and Capital Fund to allow the Parks Department to maintain the parks system using unspent previously allocated funds. This bill will allow the Parks Department to complete the following: Park Maintenance Study, perform electrical repairs throughout the park system, purchase various operating materials, chemicals, mulch, trees and lawn equipment. It will also place \$128,000 in the Golf Fund Capital Program for irrigation repairs. The Rose Garden pavilion number three will also be replaced at an estimated cost of \$22,700 through Capital Project 1905 (Park and Playground Improvements). Also, a new dug-out will be built at Keck Park at the baseball diamond at an estimated cost of \$20,800 through Capital Project 1652 (Keck and Roosevelt Park Improvements).

15-760 Bill 18

Amending the 2016 General Fund budget by deleting the position of Equipment Operator II (09M) and adding the position of Equipment Operator III (10M) in the Bureau of Street Maintenance. The purpose of this bill is to take a currently vacant EO 2 position (primarily a tandem truck driving position) and upgrade it to an EO 3, a more versatile position whose primary functions include the following: Street sweepers, asphalt rollers, front end loaders, paving machines, dozers, all size dump trucks and trailers. The upgrade will allow for a more flexible range of use of the employee. This change will also take what is basically a single dimensional position and make it multi-dimensional.

Mr. Roger MacLean stated that it was voted on, but it was not an unanimous vote.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that the vote was 2 - 1 to move it forward to the entire Council. Dr. McGuire and I vote to move it to full Council without a recommendation.

Mr. Daryl Hendricks stated that as Mr. Hunsicker pointed out and asked about the three other positions. He asked Mr. Messinger to look at the positions that are being paid out of grade. He stated that he will probably be voting to approve this position/upgrade.

Mr. Craig Messinger stated that we actually looking at that and that is something that we will be coming to you with.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked any other comments from my colleagues about Bill 18.

Mr. Julio Guridy stated that he is for it. I like the flexibility of it for the employees and he thinks it is the right move right now.

Mr. Roger MacLean stated that it was voted 2 - 1 to move to City Council with no recommendations. My vote was to move it to City Council with a recommendation.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that he moved it without a recommendation to the entire City Council and Dr. McGuire seconded and you voted no.

Ms. Shawn Dethlefsen stated that Mr. MacLean said that he was saying no to moving it without a recommendation.

Ms. Candida Affa stated that Mr. MacLean did that for the benefit of the people that were not here.

Dr. David McGuire stated that he voted to bring this forward. There was a very large discussion about this, including that in 2012 a discussion between a worker representation and city government had made certain arrangements. It is now a little later. I would have thought that matter of the Bill here was related to the previous history. The city government should have approached the labor representatives about the matter.

Mr. Ray O'Connell thanked Dr. McGuire and asked any other questions from my colleagues or the public.

Mr. Ryan Hunsicker stated that we are contesting this based on the

Memorandum of Understanding that was signed with the city in 2012. We will proceed going forward in the collective bargaining agreement in this matter.

Mr. Julio Guridy asked if passing this Bill, the administration is not abiding by the contract.

Mr. Ryan Hunsicker stated that he will consult with his legal department. I would assume that there will be a grievance on this.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that it was explained by the administration and explained to Mr. MacLean, myself and Dr. McGuire it is not in violation of the contract. It is the management's prerogative.

Mr. Craig Messinger stated that Mr. Marchetto, Manager of Human Resources said that as far as what we are doing with this upgrade has nothing to do with the actual upgrade of that position prior.

Mr. Glen Hunsicker stated that it seems to be a simple thing. The SEIU is coming up at the end of the year. It really should be a contractual thing.

Mr. Ray O'Connell thanked Mr. Hunsicker and asked anyone else from the public.

Mr. Roger MacLean stated that when he was with the Police Department, they saw the need to add more Sergeant. We didn't reduce the number of rank we added to it.

Mr. Glen Hunsicker stated that everyone wants somebody to improve and move up in grade.

Mr. Greg Hoffman - SEIU, stated that the EO3 Council is looking at is his old EO2. He is now in housing/rental and has moved up. There are MW2s that he knows that would like to be an EO2 that has a lot of time in the city. They would like to move up to that position. We have three guys currently that are being paid out of class for over a year.
