Authorization for Engagement of Professional Services with <u>Community Bike Works</u> in the amount of \$3,000 for the certified instruction of biking safety skills for youth cyclists.

WHEREAS, Article 130.16 of the City's Administrative Code requires City Council approval by Resolution for the award of contracts or engagement of professional services.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Allentown to enter into an agreement/engage the services of the following named contractor/consultant, for the use and purpose indicated in supporting the Recommendation of Award of Bid or Contract dated January 19, 2018:

- 1. Name of Contractor/Consultant: Community Bike Works
- 2. Project or Contract Reference: Bicycle Education
- 3. Description of Service(s) to be provided: Community Bike works will provide bicycle education including: bike safety and repair, trail rides and mountain bike rides.

- Description of project or scope of services to be provided:
 - 1. Bike Safety and Repair Students will work with staff to prepare a fleet of bicycles for student use.
 - 2. Trail Rides Students will ride with staff and volunteers on various trails in Allentown and the Lehigh Valley with a focus on riding skills, bicycle safety and exposure to various types of riding.
 - 3. Mountain Bike Rides students will build and maintain a mountain bike trail; then they will learn how to ride mountain bikes.
- State the actual or estimated price to the City or the proposed Department budget allowance for the initial term; and state payment rate per unit of service if applicable:

Bicycle Safety and Repair- Spring 2018 - 3 staff will teach students for 24 hours each = \$1,000 Trail Rides - April 1 - June 30, 2018 - 3 staff will ride with students for 24 hours each = \$1,000 Mountain Bike Rides - March - June, 2 staff will teach students to ride mountain bikes for 36 hours each = \$1,000 Total Contract Sum \$3,000.00
