Proposal Summaries 42nd Year

Ms. Heidi Baer thanked Council and stated that this is the 42nd Year of the Community Development Block Grant Program. The consolidated grant program consists of three pots of Federal money, the Community Development Block Grant Program, the Home Investment Partnership Program, and the Emergency Solutions Grant program, Each of these pots of money have its own rules and regulations. We did see a slight increase in our funds. Our CDBG Dollars are about \$55,316 more than last year. Our Home Program is about \$51,304, and ESG we received a \$1,744 more. Last year, we came before you and approved the Consolidated Plan which is our five year strategy from 2015 - 2020. Our allocation looks pretty much the same for previous years.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that you gave an overview and it looks like the same participants applied.

Ms. Heidi Baer stated that the city had several agencies that requested funding last year, that did not come before of this year. Mr. Guridy is always interested in Casa Guadalupe Center. They are still working on their program. They opted not to apply for this year. The DaVinci Science Center that was new last year and we are still working with them to finalize

what their program will be.

Mr. Julio Guridy asked if the city has money for homelessness.

Ms. Heidi Baer stated that the Emergency Solutions Grant Program. If you look at the One Year Action Plan Draft and it give you a description of each program.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked any other comments or questions from my colleagues. He stated that he sees the score in the 80s, 90s, and one score that is not good. Is there like a cut-off score?

Ms. Heidi Baer stated that this year it really wasn't because we had the funding available. If the agencies really score low, we want to work with them to beef up their score. I offer technical assistance, not only during CDBG Funding application time, but any time nonprofits come in and ask about grant funding.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked any other questions for Ms. Baer and Ms. Calluori about the overview.

Ms. Heidi Baer stated years ago there was a pot of money for rental rehabilitation program which has ceased probably 20 years ago. We get repayments for some of the funds that we put out for the rehabilitation of rental units in the city. In the last year, we only received \$16,000 in repayments.

Mr. Julio Guridy asked what do we do with that money.

Ms. Heidi Baer stated that we make it available to landlords if they are interested. It is a lower three percent loan which requires a match. We don't really advertise it much because in a half of a day, the money would be gone. They do have to rent to low and moderate income persons.
