AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2019 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) from AARP to assist with the purchase of benches and shade structures for the Dixon Street Dog Park.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2019 Capital Fund in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) reflecting receipt of monies from AARP to assist with the purchase of benches and shade structures for the Dixon Street Dog Park.
