

## CITY OF ALLENTOWN

30821 RESOLUTION R31 – 2024

## Introduced by the City Council on February 21, 2024

Council recommends ARPA funds not appropriated be directed to towards offsetting any potential tax increase and used for critical infrastructure projects.

## Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown faces critical infrastructure needs – inclusive of a Police and Fire Station and well as for adequate facilities for Parks and Recreation employees; and

**WHEREAS,** leadership was lacking both in terms of the use of ARPA funds and the city's capital needs, the city has not created a capital projects plan for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, Allentown City Council during this last budget cycle was adamant in not supporting a tax increase to the taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, using ARPA funds to offset potential tax increases would impact the city residents in the greatest possible way.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Allentown that \$1.2M in ARPA funds be used as a revenue replacement in the General Fund; \$1.2M be transferred into a CED Account for disbursement; and that an application process be developed within a month.

Amendment: that \$1.2M in ARPA funds be used as a revenue replacement in the General Fund; \$1.2M be transferred into a CED Account for disbursement; and that an application process be developed within a month passed, 7 - 0.
