AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2023 General Budget to provide for a transfer of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000) Dollars, Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars from the unappropriated balance to the Mayor's Office, Account 46, Other Contract Services and Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars from the unappropriated balance to the Council's Office, Account 46, Other Contract Services accounts to hire a consultant to provide the City with a legal and policy analysis of the Allentown Parking Authority regarding operational options inclusive of but not limited to residential parking, parking enforcement, governance structures, parking garage management, and debt structures.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That the City Council authorizes a transfer in the amount of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars to the following accounts:
