## Introduced by the Administration on May 1, 2024

Authorization for Contract with Michael Baker International, Inc. for an estimated yearly sum of \$100,000.00 to provide technical assistance and assist the City with compliance with its HUD Entitlement Programs and other grant programs as needed. Specific compliance reports and activities include but are not limited to the Five-Year Community and Development Block Grant Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plans, Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report, Analysis of Impediments to further Fair Housing and Environmental Reviews. Proposals must meet all federal regulations and provide a strategically coordinated approach to revitalize neighborhoods and improve the City with its various partners. In addition, all proposals must align with projects supported by federal funding, specifically CDBG, ESG, HOME, and HOPWA.

**WHEREAS,** Article 130.16 of the City's Administrative Code (recodified as §5-21) requires City Council approval by Resolution for the award of contracts or engagement of professional services.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Allentown to enter into an agreement with the aforementioned Contractor, for the use and purpose indicated in supporting the Recommendation of Award of Bid:

Description of project or scope of services to be provided:

On February 20, 2024, the City advertised a solicitation for a professional planning and community development consultant to provide technical assistance and assist the City with compliance with its HUD Entitlement Programs and other grant programs as needed. Specific compliance reports and

activities include but are not limited to the Five-Year Community and Development Block Grant Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plans, Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report, Analysis of Impediments to further Fair Housing and Environmental Reviews. Proposals must meet all federal regulations and provide a strategically coordinated approach to revitalize neighborhoods and improve the City with its various partners. In addition, all proposals must align with projects supported by federal funding, specifically CDBG, ESG, HOME, and HOPWA. On March 19, 2024, the public opening was held for which five (5) proposals were received, however, one (1) proposal was rejected due to including cost in their Technical proposal. The remaining four (4) proposals were distributed to all committee members via Teams for evaluation. The Technical evaluation was held on March 27, 2024, all committee members were present. The proposals were scored based on the following: IBE Preference (10 Points), Ability to Meet RFP Requirements (30 Points), Qualifications of Specified People (30 Points), and Prior Experience (15 Points). The Cost proposals were opened on March 27, 2024, and distributed to all committee members via Teams for evaluation after the completion of the Technical evaluation. The Cost evaluation was held on April 2, 2024, all committee members were present. The committee members discussed the Cost proposals (25 Points). The committee did not feel it was necessary to move forward with oral presentation. The evaluation committee completed both Technical and Cost evaluations on the proposals, the committee decided to award based on the firm's qualifications and overall score. The committee is recommending award to Michael Baker International, Inc.

## Contract Term:

The contract term shall commence upon full execution and shall cease on March 31, 2025.

Upon written agreement, this contract may be extended for four (4) one (1) year terms.
