AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2025 Grant Fund to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from the PA State Office of the Budget RACP grant. These funds are a pass-through grant that will support the Da Vinci Science Center.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the Grant Fund in the amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) from PA State Office of the Budget as follows:

Department of Community and Economic Development. This Bill is the result of the successful application and award of the RACP grant for Da Vinci Science Center.

- **Summary and facts of the bill.**

The Da Vinci Science Center, the Subgrantee, has submitted a formal application to the State Office of the Budget, for which the City will serve as the Grantee. The DaVinci Science Center has been awarded an additional \$2,000,000 in Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) funds that will support the Downtown Allentown project.

This Bill distributes funds as specified within the RACP grant application and award regulations.

The expenses will be appropriated to the Grant Fund, 005-01-0201-0078-50048.
