## 2023 Annual Report of Allentown Environmental Advisory Council

## **ACTIVITY**

In 2023 the Allentown Environmental Advisory Council developed and implemented the following goals and actions as outlined below. In addition, the EAC developed a refined set of goals for the Council to drive outcomes over 2024.

## What we have accomplished in 2023:

- Sustainability Coordinator in the budget.
  - → The position is currently posted.
  - → Relationship development will need to occur between the new hire and the EAC to ensure the success of the candidate.
- Allentown submitted its CDP response. Allentown's score improved to a B, up from a C last year.
  - → The CDP response is a big step towards transparency in the City's climate actions
- The EAC received the Bird Town grant of \$500 to implement a monthly environmental awareness program for children at the Allentown Public Library in 2024.
  - → We hosted our first event 01/13/2024
- With assistance from interns from Muhlenberg and Northampton Community College.
  - → We successfully researched and filed a comprehensive report and recommendations on how the city can cost-effectively move forward with energy efficiency and renewable energy programs for city-owned assets as well as residents and businesses in Allentown.
- Assisted the City in successfully applying for and receiving a shared energy manager to help the City to implement the EAC's recommendations on energy efficiency and renewable energy. Obtained PA DEP Funding.
- Successfully applied for 4 Muhlenberg interns to work with the EAC on updating the City's Greenhouse Gas inventory, implementing the Allentown Library Bird Town program, and improving outreach, communications and document management.
- Obtained commitment from an additional Muhlenberg student to be the overall Muhlenberg liaison for the Allentown EAC.
- Participated in a major cleanup event organized by Real Recognize Real
- Participated in the City's Earth Day program.
- Completed and submitted an evaluation and recommendations to the City on incorporating Bird Town metrics in EAC and City programs.
- Conducted extensive evaluation with stakeholder input on whether to recommend adoption of a plastic bag ordinance. Concluded not to recommend this

- 6. Lead and Manage Muhlenberg Interns in Updating the City's Greenhouse Gas Inventory and develop separate inventories for emissions from municipal operations and City-wide emissions [Tinku]
- 7. Continue AEAC Involvement in Community Education Programs including programs regarding air quality, lead and PFAS [Maria]
