No. RESOLUTION R77 - 2025

Introduced by the Administration on June 18, 2025

Approves the submission of a formal grant application to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the construction of Phase 2 of the Martin Luther King (MLK) Trail. The City is asking for \$300,000 in grant funding with no match required.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, that

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the DCNR Administrative Projects grant under the Community Conservation Partnership Program will allow funds for the construction of Phase 2 of the Martin Luther King (MLK) trail.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Allentown Department of Parks and Recreation will assure the provision of other necessary funds to make the activity feasible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources will tentatively fund \$300,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriate officer of the City of Allentown is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this resolution and to furnish a copy of this resolution to The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
