AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2026 Capital Fund Budget to provide for an increase of One Million Eighty-Seven Thousand and Three Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$1,087,390.00) to fund the upgrade to the intersection of 19th Street and Roth Avenue as part of the Green Light Go (GLG) Grant the City was awarded. This grant is partially reimbursable and requires match funding.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the 2026 Capital Fund in the amount of One Million Eight-Seven Thousand and Three Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$1,087,390.00) reflecting receipt of Seven Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty Dollars (\$798,480.00) in funding awarded through the Green Light Go Grant

SECTION TWO: The 25% match required of One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$199,620) and additional necessary funding of Eighty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$89,290) will come from the City's General Fund Cash account

SECTION THREE: That City Council authorizes supplemental appropriation to the Capital Fund Public Works Department budget as follows:
