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AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2019 Capital Fund Budget by transferring from Capital Project 1282 – Hamilton Street Safety Improvements from 10<sup>th</sup> Street, Capital Project 1283 – Hamilton Street Safety Improvements from 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Mack Boulevard Traffic Calming Improvements into Capital Project 1803 Bridge Repairs for a total transfer amount of Sixty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars and Ninety Cents (\$69,597.90).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

The City is in the process of bidding the 2nd Street bridge replacement project. Project is currently budgeted under the Bridge Repair Capital Project (001-03-1803-0001-\*)
