RESOLUTION

R60 - 2025

Introduced by the Administration on May 7, 2025

Authorizes the submission of a formal application for funding from the Safe Streets and Roads for All Implementation Grant Opportunity in the amount of Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000) with a 20% City match requirement for safety upgrades and reconfiguration of Tilghman Street and Union Boulevard.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from the Safe Streets and Roads for All Implementation Grant, for safety upgrades and reconfiguration of Tilghman Street and Union Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Allentown City Council, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown to submit the application for approximately Seven Million Dollars (\$7,000,000) to the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) federal grant program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown hereby designates Matt Tuerk, Mayor, and Bina Patel, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements with the City of Allentown to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.

The City is submitting a formal application for the 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All Implementation Grant Opportunity in the amount of approximately \$7,000,000.

The funds will be used to complete safety upgrades and reconfiguration of Tilghman Street & Union Boulevard.

This resolution is a requirement of the formal application to demonstrate the City's goals and timelines regarding eliminating roadway injuries and fatalities.

These grant funds will be used for the planning and managing of the SS4A grant previously awarded to us in 2023. It will improve the overall safety of the City of Allentown's roadways.

This bill supports the city's priorities by enhancing road safety for all users, aligning with the mission to create a safer, healthier, and more accessible community for everyone.

The city is requesting funding in the amount of approximately \$7,000,000. This project requires a 20% match.

This project will provide necessary safety improvements along Allentown's #1 High Injury network.

This grant is due June 20, 2025, and will be submitted with the application.
