Goals of the Committee

Information Needed related to penalties – imprisonment; collect data on current process - e.g., Can we find out how many warrants have been issued; how many people who are arrested for low level things also have warrants out for arrest; how many boots issued; how many tickets go unpaid; how many people have been incarcerated under the provisions of the city code; incarcerated under provisions of state law relating city action; how do penalties work, do they act as a deterrent; are there other options, etc. Look at data from the Reading Parking Authority to show how them eliminating the incarceration has helped , hurt , or hadn't effect on their effectiveness.

City Purview: Items in the Code that can be impacted through council action.

End Product

Bill 92 Public Safety, Recommended Unfavorably 2-1 - wait until alternative penalty is found. Needs an amendment to change sections to reflect codification.
Amending Article 531, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 531.99 Notice of Violation; Waiver (H) by deleting a provision that states that in default of payment of fine and costs, someone could be imprisoned not more than ten days.
