1. <u>A-69655</u> <u>133-135 S. 17th St.</u> Appeal of Matthew Leon to MAINTAIN 4TH DWELLING UNIT, with residential conversion not permitted; being a change of a non-conforming use & being a change of use granted by the Zoning Hearing Board under Application No. 55435 on February 19, 2001, located in a Medium Density Residential (RM), Historic Building Demolition Overlay (HBDO) & Traditional Neighborhood Development Overlay (TNDO) District.

2. <u>A-69660</u> <u>602 N. 16th St.</u> Appeal of Valley Beneficial, Inc. for R & S Auto Tags and Notary for variance to maintain two window signs (8.83 ft. x 5.58 ft. at front and 5.08 ft. x 5.16 ft. at south side), both non-illum., being a change of Condition (a) of Zoning Hearing Board Application No. 69002 granted on June 11, 2018, located in a Medium High Density Residential (R-MH) and Traditional Neighborhood Development Overlay (TNDO) District.

3. <u>A-69662</u> <u>1228 Turner St.</u> Appeal of Rudolph Amelio Jr. for Shehadeh Investments for variance to CONVERT VACANT OFFICE TO OFFICE and ERECT 3 SIGNS, (1 @ 3 ft. X 3.33 ft. flat wall) & (2 @ 1.67 ft. x 3.33 ft. window) with use and signs permitted by Special Exception under Article 1314.02.C.4., located in a Medium High Density Residential (RMH), Traditional Neighborhood Development Overlay (TNDO) and Historic Building Demolition Overlay (HBDO) District. In the alternative, the applicant requests a continuation of a non-conforming use.
