BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the amount of Three Hundred Eleven Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty Nine Dollars and Seventy One Cents (\$311,749.71) as follows:
