#### AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2023 ARPA Fund by transferring One Million (\$1,000,000) Dollars from the ARPA Fund to the General Fund for the 1528 West Hamilton St. Affordable Housing Project being developed by HDC-Mid Atlantic. 100% of the funds will be used to offset construction costs of the project.

The Bill is necessary to appropriate \$1,000,000 of ARPA funding to HDC Mid Atlantic's 1528 West Hamilton Street Affordable housing project

The Bill will allow the City to grant \$1,000,000 of ARPA funding to help cover a \$1.6 million dollar funding gap in HDC Mid Atlantic's 1528 West Hamilton St. affordable housing project. The project will create 49 deeply affordable housing units and has a total cost estimate of \$19,390,595. The Bill will advance Principle #2 of the Housing Section of Vision 2030: Increase the quantity of healthy, safe and affordable housing.
