HISTORY OF THE PORTION OF THE STREET PROPOSED TO BE VACATED:

The portion of street proposed to be vacated is in the 6th Ward. The street was established by City Ordinance Bill No. 503 on April 18th 1917. The street became obsolete when the Tilghman Street Bridge was adopted by Ordinance Bill No. 2122 on August 30th, 1927. Should the subject portion of the street vacation be granted, it appears that the affected right-of-way would revert to the adjoining property owners which is the street vacation requestor. It is the responsibility of the affected adjoining property to assimilate vacated property into fee simple ownership by deed.

LOCATION AND CONDITION:

The subject street area is closed to traffic and the PA DOT owned Tilghman Street bridge is constructed on the subject area. PA DOT enjoys an aerial easement and bridge Pier construction and maintenance easements for the Bridge. There is any existing storm line that is under the bridge and a 20' wide Drainage Easement has been provided by the requestor.




