AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2016 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars as a result of a funding from Lehigh Valley Health Network to provide for Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) materials and equipment.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2016 General Fund in the amount of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars reflecting receipt of monies from Lehigh Valley Health Network to purchase materials and equipment for CPR training.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

What Department or bureau is Bill originating from? Where did the initiative for the bill originate?

This Bill originated in Health. LVHN has made a \$10,000 contribution available to cover the purchase of automatic defibrillators and CPR training materials in exchange for health staff participating in a task force on geriatric workforce education.

Summary and Facts of the Bill

This allocation will be used to purchase three AEDS needed by the city as well as educational materials needed for staff and citizen CPR classes.

Purpose -

The Bill allows the City to have the equipment necessary to teach additional CPR classes and to hopefully save lives.

These funds must be spent by December 31, 2016.
