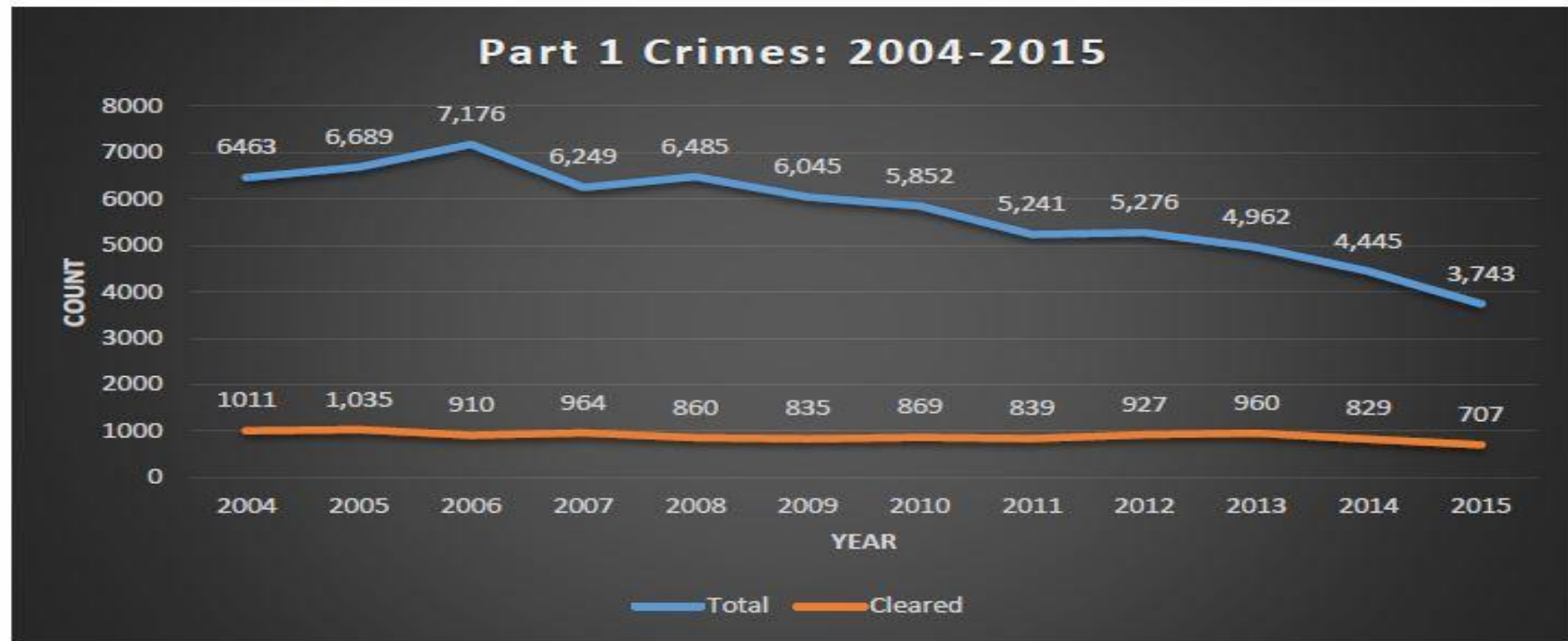

Citywide Part-1 Crime Charts: 2004 – 2015

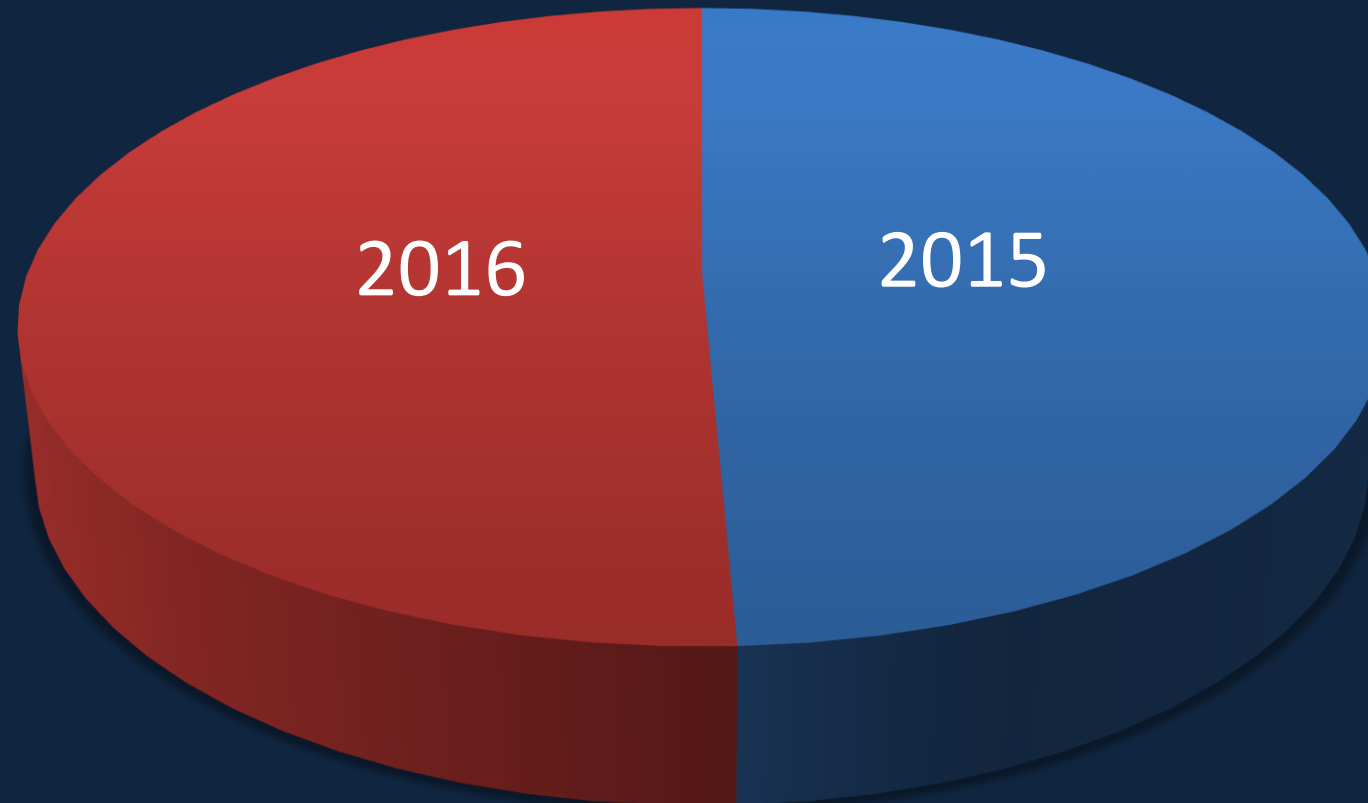
