Recommends the Administration post the following signage on 7<sup>th</sup> Street: **Calle Siete** - in recognition and appreciation of the contributions, perspectives and value Latinos and Spanish speaking people add to our City

## Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

**Whereas**, Allentown City Council recognizes, supports and appreciates a diversity of worldviews and cultural knowledge across a range of groups - race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, economic class, religion and abilities; and

Whereas, Allentown City Council takes great pride in the city's cultural diversity and the role the Hispanic-American community plays in the City; and

Whereas, the City's Latino population is approaching 50% and the city has not named a park, street or community asset recognizing their contribution to the city and being an integral part of the city's development and heritage.

**Now Therefore Be It Resolved**, Allentown City Council in recognition and appreciation of the contributions, perspectives and value of Latinos and the Spanish speaking people add to our city hereby recommends the Administration post with the existing signage on 7<sup>th</sup> Street:

**Calle Siete**
