AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance of the City of Allentown, Council of Lehigh and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, establishing the Administrative Order Fund for 2016.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes the creation of the Administrative Order Fund (080) as part of the City of Allentown 2016 Budget.

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
