Good morning, Jim.

The Judicial Code, 42 Pa.C.S.A § 8902, authorizes the police to arrest without a warrant upon probable cause persons engaged in the offenses of disorderly conduct, public drunkenness, obstruction of highways and public passages and purchasing/consumption/possession or transportation of liquor or malt/brewed beverages, but guidelines for this right of arrest must first be established by the governing body.

Section 8902 (b) states:

Part Seven (General Offenses Code), Article 730 (Disturbing the Peace) of the Codified Ordinances does not contain any authorization for warrantless arrests. I checked with the City Clerk's Office to see if there had been any amendments to these sections. Tawanna Whitehead investigated and found none.

There is currently no City Ordinance to offer the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police Association as proof that the City is in compliance with Accreditation Standard 1.2.4.

We will need to see if this amendment interacts with the current provisions with regard to the Penalty section.
