RESOLUTION

Introduced by the Administration on April 5, 2017

Authorizes Submission for a DCNR Grant for the Construction of a Skate Park at Jordan Park in the amount of \$200,000

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown is desirous of constructing a Skate Park at Jordan Park;

and

WHEREAS, funding for this project is available through a Department of Conservation and National Resources (DCNR) grant in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000) Dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Allentown, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown to submit the application for Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000) Dollars in Department of Conservation and National Resources Grant Funding.

The City is submitting an application to the DCNR for development funds in support of the Jordan Park Skate Park project. The resolution is needed as part of the application, which is due April 12.
