Amending the 2016 Capital Project Fund Budget to provide for a transfer of Twenty Eight Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty One Dollars and Twenty One Cents (\$28,351.21) to complete payment to Langan Engineering for work that has been completed at the Jackson Street Playground.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an transfer for the unappropriated balance of the Capital Project Fund in the amount of Twenty Eight Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty One Dollars and Twenty One Cents (\$28,351.21) reflecting a transfer within the Capital Project Fund.
