#### AN ORDINANCE

Amending Article 1741.99 – Property Rehabilitation and Maintenance Code Penalty, by increasing violation ticket fines and penalties from \$25 to \$100.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That the Fees portion of Section 1741.99, Allentown Codified Ordinances, be amended as follows:

### 1741.99 PENALTY

### E. Violation Ticket Fines

- 1. Violation tickets shall be issued in the amount of Twenty-five (\$25) One Hundred (\$100) Dollars.
- 2. Any person who receives a violation ticket for any violation of this Article, may, within ten (10) days, admit the violation, waive a hearing and pay the fine in full satisfaction of Twenty-five (\$25) dollars One Hundred \$100) Dollars as indicated on the violation ticket.

## F. Violation Ticket Penalties

- 1. If the person in receipt of a Twenty five (\$25) One Hundred (\$100) Dollar violation ticket does not pay the fine or request a hearing within ten (10) days, the person will be subject to a ten (\$10) dollar penalty for days eleven (11) through twenty (20).
- 2. Failure of the person to make payment within twenty (20) days shall make the person subject to a citation.

SECTION TWO: That this Ordinance takes effect on January 1, 2018.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

# Summary and Facts of the Bill

The Department is requesting to amend Ordinance 14561, at Article 1741.99 – Penalty.

Currently a violation ticket is issued with a cost of \$25.00. The owner receives the ticket, has ten (10) days to comply with the violation, waive the hearing and pay the \$25.00 fine in full.

The amendment is to propose an increase from \$25.00 to \$100.00 for a violation ticket.

The current requirements would remain the same that is the violation ticket is not paid within ten (10) days of receipt, a penalty of \$10.00 will be added to the ticket.

Failure of the owner to make payment within twenty (20) days will result in a citation being filed.
