HISTORY OF THE PORTION OF THE STREET PROPOSED TO BE VACATED:

The portion of street proposed to be vacated is in the 19th Ward. Rhodes Street was created by the Subdivision Plan of "Fairview Manor" laid out in 1927 as part of Salisbury Township. The City annexed this portion of Salisbury Township and accepted the existing street system on May 14th, 1931 by Ordinance No. 2673.

LOCATION AND CONDITION:

The subject unopened street to be vacated was mapped to be a Twenty (20) foot right-of-way. The paper street consists of lawn and a wooded area. No existing utilities are known within the Paper Street. If the subject street vacation is granted, the underling owners could assimilate the vacated property into fee simple ownership by deed.








Proposed Street Vacation: Rhodes St. @ Mack Blvd. to S. 10th St.


