## AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2017 Capital Fund Budget by transferring the available balance from Capital Project 1210 – Sewage Relief Interceptor and Capital Project 1727 – SSES Rehabilitation to Capital Project 1227 – Automatic Meter Reading and Bill in the amount of One Million Two Hundred Fourteen Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-One Dollars and Twenty-One Cents (\$1,214,691.21) to correct the existing negative balance.
