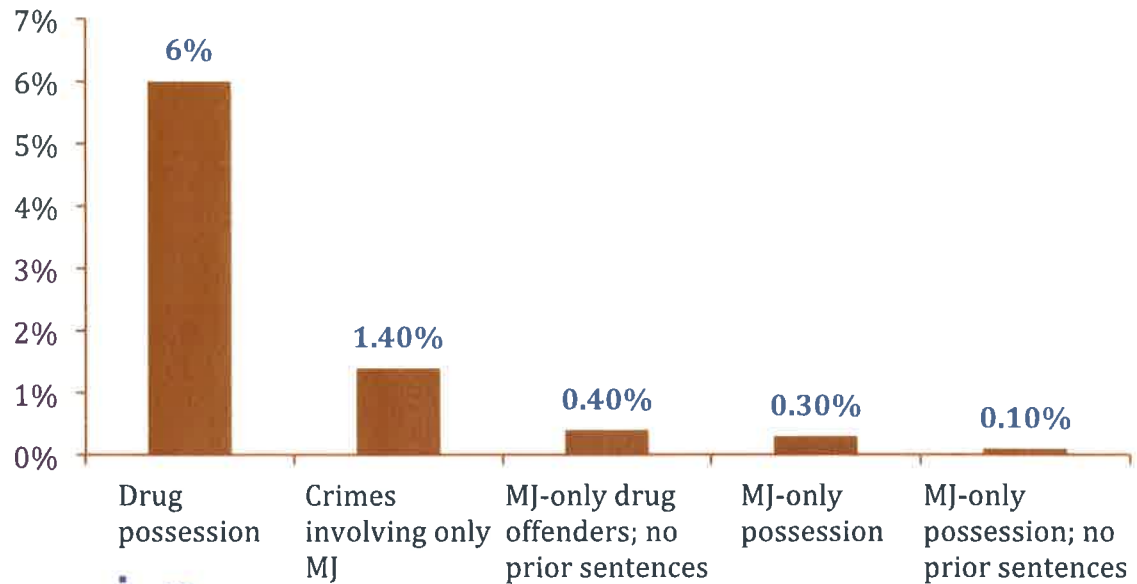


WOULD LEGAL MARIJUANA REDUCE OUR CRIMINAL JUSTICE COSTS?

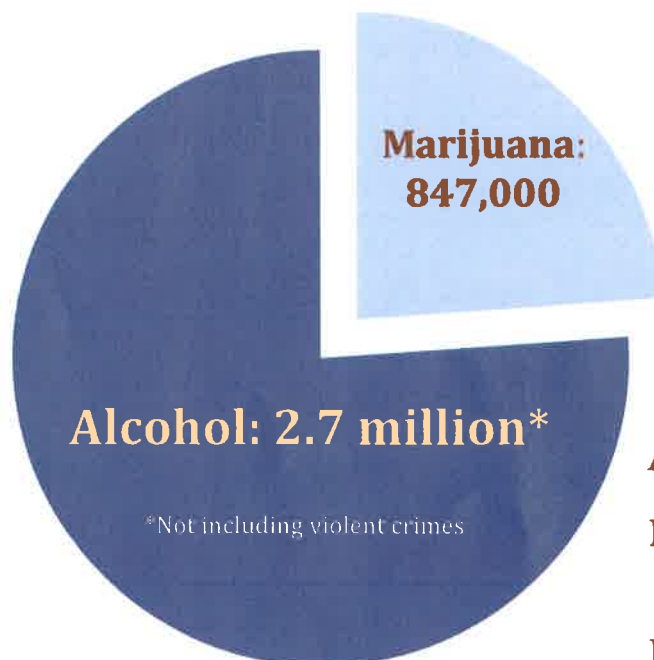


Only **0.4%** of prisoners with no prior offenses are in jail for **marijuana possession**
