#### AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2018 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Eighty-Seven Thousand Two-Hundred Seventy-Three (\$87,273.00) Dollars as a result of a grant from FEMA US Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters Grant, to the Allentown Fire Department to provide for Personal Bailout System Kits and PPE Retrofit.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2018 General Fund in the amount of Eighty-Seven Thousand Two-Hundred and Seventy-Three Dollars (\$87,273.00) reflecting receipt of monies from a grant from FEMA US Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters Grant, to the Allentown Fire Department to provide for Personal Bailout system kits and PPE retrofit.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to the Fire Department budget as follows:

Fire Suppression/Extinguishment

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

The bill reflects the grant award of \$87,273.00 of monies from FEMA US Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters grant to be used to purchase personal bail out system kits and PPE retrofit for the Allentown Fire Department.

The Bill will provide funding for the purchase of personal bail out system kits and PPE retrofit for the Allentown Fire Department. This funding establishes the funds necessary to procure essential fire service related personal protective equipment to protect our Fire career personnel and to assist in the efficiency and services provided by the Allentown Fire Department which will result in life safety to the citizens of Allentown and our Fire personnel.

This allows us to be compliant with NFPA 1500 Standards on Occupational Safety and to equip our firefighters with the necessary equipment to perform a self-rescue from an elevation and will allow our firefighters to properly train on emergency egress procedures so that the Allentown Fire Department is able to meet the response and demands of all emergency services as well as to ensure Allentown citizens are protected on a daily basis. Downside – Failure to have functional, proper and adequate equipment may result in injury or the unthinkable Line of Duty Death within our agency.

This Bill relates to the City's vision and mission by providing equipment to ensure all Fire personnel will be properly trained to protect and serve the citizens of Allentown and provide a safe City for all who live, work and visit the City of Allentown. It has always been the City of Allentown's priority, as well as every elected official to provide safe and efficient Public Safety services to ensure a safe environment.
