AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2018 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500) Dollars from the Iron Pigs Charities to the City of Allentown to assist with the completion of the Skate Park at Keck Park.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2018 Capital Fund in the amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars reflecting receipt of monies from the Iron Pigs Charities to the City of Allentown to assist with the completion of the dog skate park.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Fund as follows:
