Summary and Facts of the Bill

The Animal Control Program is in the Bureau of Recycling and Solid Waste and funding for the program is out of the Solid Waste Fund. The City is under contract with the Lehigh County Humane Society (LCHS) for the various animal control services.

Contract No. C2012-175 / RFP 2012-40 expired January 28, 2018 and the new Contract No. C21-000024 was fully executed on January 29, 2018.

In September 2018, the Bureau was contacted by LCHS to inform the City that an audit had been performed and LCHS realized they failed to invoice the City for the first quarter payment of 2017 under the old contract.

The City verified that this payment was not made for services rendered during the 1st Quarter of 2017.

Therefore, this Bill serves to transfer money from the Unappropriated Balance in the Solid Waste Fund to the Animal Control Program in the Solid Wase Fund, Account Number 085-03-8005-0004-46, in order to pay the invoice submitted by LCHS in September 2018.
